1. A primary focus of the U.S. Congress this past year has been to reform health care and health insurance in the United States. Please briefly explain your recommendations for reform and the roles of the government and private sector in your proposal.

I HAVE A RATHER GOOD, SHARED-PREMIUMS-COST HEALTH PLAN IN MY RETIREMENT, AND HAVE ACTUALLY DECLINED MEDICARE B. NEVERTHELESS, I FEEL STRONGLY THAT MEDICARE SHOULD NOT BE PLUNDERED IN ORDER TO FINANCE COVERAGE OF THOSE WHO HAVE NOT CHOSEN TO PAY INTO SOME HEALTH INSURANCE SYSTEM.
